Next Steps for Newly Admitted Ph.D. students -International Students-

Before arrival:

- Activate your <u>USC e-mail and USC NetID.</u>
- Access <u>MyUSC</u> and <u>OASIS</u>
- Review <u>Immunizations and Screenings Requirements</u> and submit your proof to Health Center by the add/drop deadline.
- Sign up for <u>Passport Verification (PPV)</u>.
- Check your proficiency in English on the letter of admission and your I-20 (No.6), and review <u>International Student English (ISE) exam</u> policies. Please note if your English proficiency scores are below the exam requirements, we recommend you take the appropriate test again to avoid taking the ISE exam.
- Bring all your original diploma and transcripts with you to USC to prepare for the degree verification.

After arrival:

- Attend Passport Verification (PPV).
- Get your <u>USC ID card</u> at the USCard Services (after PPV on campus).
- Take the International Student English (ISE) exam (if applicable).
- By the add/drop deadline, submit the <u>correct immunization and blood test proof</u> to USC Health Center.
- Contact <u>academic advisor</u> in your department for your academic plan.
- Attend a Viterbi-One Stop Session or meet with your department to set up your assistantship or fellowship.
- Access <u>MyUSC</u> and <u>OASIS</u> to get your permit to register and your registration time.

- Complete your <u>Mandatory Training for Grad Students</u>

- Before the end of the first semester, complete your <u>international prior degree</u> <u>verification</u>. Note: We recommend that you bring all your original diploma and updated transcript with you to USC.
